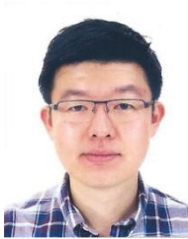


**YONG EE HOU**

He joined the Nanyang Technological University as an Assistant Professor in Physics and Applied Physics in 2014 and his group is working on a range of problems in theoretical biophysics, from pattern formation to complexity.
