Jan is the Director of Para Limes at NTU. He graduated in 1972 in physics at the Technical University of Delft. During his rich career Jan held various positions both in research and in government, the latter one included his stationing as Attaché for Science and Technology of the Dutch Government in Washington and Ottawa. He also held industry positions and in 1994 he founded Prisma & Partners, a firm dedicated to finding, strengthening and mobilizing the innovative capacity of companies, organizations and regions. In 2003 he initiated Institute Para Limes; currently, he is its Founding President. In August 2011 he moved to Singapore to become Director of the Complexity Programme at Nanyang Technological University. Jan is author of four books, all related to his own work.
