

Per ROLAND

Per is one of the early pioneers and patriarchs of the functional mapping of the human brain who, among others, for the first time described with functional neuroimaging techniques the localisation of motor functions in the human brain and measured the 'energetic costs' of thinking. His book *Brain Activation* has been and is the bible of the functional localisation of functions in the human brain. Roland is a professor of the Karolinska Institute, Stockholm, as well as the University of Copenhagen.
