Mr. William Clune currently has a joint appointment at Nanyang Technological University as Assistant Director of Environmental Policy at the Sustainable Earth Office and Senior Lecturer in Law & Economics in the Division of Economics.

Prior to these appointments, Mr. Clune was as an environmental lawyer, consultant, and policy researcher in The United States and Sweden. He worked on environmental permitting, cleanup, litigation, and compliance matters for a diverse set of clients and organizations from the private sector, in government, and with those working in the public interest. In addition, he has undertaken or initiated many research and consulting projects with government agencies and universities in areas including water resources management, energy policy, industrial ecology, green construction, and microfinance development.

Mr. Clune graduated with distinction from Stanford University with degrees in Economics and English (BA). He obtained a Juris Doctor (JD) from The University of Chicago Law School. He completed a Master's program (MSc) in Environmental Science at The University of Wisconsin, and a Master's (MA) in Public Policy at The University of Chicago. He most recently completed a Juris Magister (LLM) in European Law from Stockholm University.

The focus of Mr. Clune's work and research at NTU is sustainable development, which he examines in the context of economic incentives, regulatory baselines, questions of governance, and environmental impact challenges. He is extending inquiries in these areas through projects related to urban planning with an emphasis on economic development in Southeast Asia.
